* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score, and Jr Handlers in all classes.

EXERCISE YOUR DOG RESPONSIBLY! PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS!

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR WARM UP AREA. THERE IS A LEASH LAW IN THE TRIAL SITE'S STATE.

We now have an online form for volunteer sign-up. The link will be included in the final confirmation email that will go out 7-10 days before the trial. During the trial, we need gate stewards, timers, scribes, bar setters, leash runners, scribe sheet runners, and course builders. Can't access the form, no problem as you can always sign up at the trial. Workers get entered in a raffle for credits toward future entries! Don't worry if you don't know how to do a job! They are easy and we can show you how

There is a \$25.00 service fee in addition to any bank fees for returned checks!

CPE general SpeedWay trial rules: see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for further info on divisions and complete details.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 12 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class.
- No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog's eyes. **Exception – Drag Race: a flat collar with nothing attached, is allowed to facilitate the catching of the dog at the end of the run.**
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, the leash must be in a pocket, out of sight of the dog.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.
- The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course.

Site Information

- **5 mph speed limit on the property. Violators will be asked to leave the trial site and no refunds will be issued.**
- *Tetz Lane is posted 30mph. IT is strongly suggested that you go no faster than 10mph between the white house on the turn and the first red barn.*
- This trial is in an indoor facility on dirt. There is designated indoor crating as well as designated outdoor tenting.
- Park only in designated areas as directed by trial officials. Do not block RV's!
- **All dogs must be on leash and under control at all times except when using the warm up area or in the ring. Unattended dogs in stalls must be contained in crates or ex-pens.**
- **No food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within ten feet of the ring at any time, exception for toys used for Declared Training in the Ring.**
- **No clickers or squeakers to be used anywhere in the building.**
- No unsupervised children shall be allowed on the premises.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted during trial hours.
- No smoking in or within 50 feet of any building.
- No unattended heaters allowed in stalls except with express permission of the Board.
- You must clean up after your dog and place waste in the receptacles provided. Failure to do so may lead to being excused from the trial.
- Absolutely NO food or treats are to be left in the arena or the stalls overnight.
- Lunch will be provided for all volunteers.
- All glass and plastic bottles are disposed of in the blue recycling containers.
- **Onsite water is NOT potable.** Please bring drinking water for yourself and dogs. (Available bottled water for volunteers only – no water available for dogs.)

WE SUGGEST THAT YOU MAKE YOUR RESERVATIONS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

ON-SITE CAMPING: Self-contained RV parking will be permitted at the trial site for a limited number of vehicles.

NO HOOKUPS. Pre-registration and payment are required. Fees are \$15 per night (\$10 if a member).

No RVs on site before **3 PM** on Friday. No overnight parking on Sunday.

The RV parking area can vary depending upon the weather and the landlord, please check your final confirmation. Skyline Agility Club, Inc. reserves the right to cancel onsite camping at the last minute if the landlord bars RVs onsite because of extreme weather conditions. A minimum of 10-12 RV spots is normally allocated. Once the RV limit is reached, a wait list may be established. If cancellations are received prior to closing date or if the RV parking area is expanded, spaces will be filled from the wait list in order of receipt. Reservation cancellations before the trial closing date will be refunded. After closing date, if the spot can be filled, a refund will be issued. Checks will be cashed after trial closing date. Members of Skyline Agility Club, Inc. can reserve spots prior to opening date. RV reservations for all open on Opening Date of a trial.

1. Park an awning length apart.
2. Venting your exhaust is required, Gen-Turi is recommended or some type of top venting. **If you are hose venting, your hose must extend safely past your neighbors' RVs to prevent your ground venting fumes from going into your neighbor's windows, or you will have to move.**
3. Please take your garbage to the end of the property where you will find the green dumpster. **Glass and bottle recycling can be taken to the blue containers in the barn.**
4. Dogs cannot be left outside all night.

TENT CAMPING: Tent campers are welcome. Fee is \$15/night (\$10/night if a member. Fill out the relevant parts of the form and mail with your payment before the trial closing date.

DAY PARKING OF RVs: Campers that can fit in a regular parking space are permitted to day park without fee. Larger RVs must contact the RV coordinator to determine whether there is space. There is no fee if the larger RV is going in and out every day as long as advance permission has been obtained.
