Entry Limits:

350 Runs Per Day

Move ups:

Move-ups allowed day to day providing the request is made no later than 15 minutes after results are posted for the last class on Saturday

No same day move-ups

Day of show Entries:

If we do not reach our limit, we may accept day of trial entries. The cost will be \$15 per run for any entries after the closing date

Refunds:

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. A dog or handler which suffers an injury and/or illness or bitches that come into season after the closing date may be eligible for a refund up to 75% of their total entry fee. Requests for said refunds must be received in writing by the completion of the event on Sunday and must include documentation from your veterinarian or physician verifying the illness or injury. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, snow, acts of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond our control.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but you cannot indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lackof, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **Skyline Agility Club, Inc.** (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), the owner or lessee of the premises and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons

From the NYS Thruway (North or South): Exit 16 - Merge onto NY- 17 W Take exit 122 - Crystal Run Crossing. Turn right onto Crystal Run Crossing. Turn left onto Crystal Run Road. Take to end - make right at stop sign - County Rd 83/ Goshen Turnpike/ Scotchtown Ave. Approximately 1.2 miles to Tetz Lane - Victoria Farms sign on left. Left onto Tetz Lane to end.

From the West – I-84 Eastbound – Take Exit 19A for NY-17 E towards New York City. Keep Right for County Rd 67/Crystal Run Rd. At traffic light, turn Left onto Crystal Run Rd, follow for 2 miles, turn Right at Stop Sign onto Goshen Turnpike/Scotchtown Ave. After 1.2 miles, turn Left onto Tetz Lane. Follow to end.

From the East – I-84 Westbound – Take Exit 19A to merge onto NY-17 towards New York City. Take Exit 122 for County Rd 67/Crystal Run Rd. ALL generators must use a mechanism (Gen-Turi or suitable exhaust hose) to direct on-board generator exhaust away from neighboring RVs. Unless extreme weather conditions or other circumstances please turn off all generators by 11 PM.

1. Park as directed by the RV Coordinator.
2. Please take your garbage to the end of the property where you will find the large garbage bin Do not take your RV garbage to the barn containers. Place recycling in containers provided in barn.
3. Dogs cannot be left outside all night.
4. Additional guidance will be emailed to you prior to the trial by the RV coordinator.

TENT CAMPING: Tent campers are welcome. Fee is \$15 per night. Tent campers are still required to register in advance of the trial. Tent campers may mail payment and completed (relevant parts) form before the trial closing date. Alternatively, they may give the form and payment to the RV coordinator on the first trial day attended

NOTES/SITE INFORMATION

- There will be set up on **Friday, March 25, at 3:00 PM.**
- Trial site will be open at 7:00 AM on **Saturday March 26, 2022** and **Sunday March 27, 2022.**
 - 5 mph speed limit on the property. Violators will be asked to leave the trial site and no refunds will be issued.
 - *Tetz Lane is posted 30mph. IT is strongly suggested that you go no faster than 10mph between the white house on the turn and the first red barn.*
 - This trial is in an indoor agility facility on dirt. There is designated indoor crating as well as designated outdoor tenting.
 - Park only in designated areas as directed by trial officials. Do not block RV's!
 - Please stay close to the barn! The fields, areas by the houses, and fenced runs in front of the building are all off limits.
 - All dogs must be on leash and under control at all times except when using the warm up area or in the agility ring. Unattended dogs in stalls must be contained in crates or ex-pens.
 - No food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within ten feet of the ring at any time, exception for toys used for Declared Training in the Ring. (See NADAC.com for updated NADAC Training in Ring Policies).
 - No clickers or squeakers to be used anywhere in the building.
 - No unsupervised children shall be allowed on the premises.
 - Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted during trial hours.
 - No smoking in or within 50 feet of any building.
 - No unattended heaters allowed in stalls except with express permission of the Board.
 - You must clean up after your dog and place waste in the receptacles provided. Failure to do so may lead to being excused from the trial.
 - Absolutely NO food or treats are to be left in the arena or the stalls overnight.
 - All glass and plastic bottles are disposed of in the blue recycling containers.
 - **Onsite water is NOT potable.** Please bring drinking water for yourself and dogs. (Available bottled water for volunteers only – no water available for dogs.)
- Exhibitors can enter the ring with a closed/sealed container (a zip log bag works well) in a pocket. The container must not be visible to the dog or anyone else and may not be opened within ten feet of the ring boundary. The difference between a containerized trial and a non-containerized trial is that when a club hosts a **containerized trial, no one may leave treats or toys around loose, either ringside or at their set up.**
